



## 1984 Unchitviya Kehar

*“Until lions have their historians, tales of the hunt shall always glorify the hunters”*

Ever since author scholar Sardar Ajmer Singh recognised the inherent truth in this Nigerian wisdom quote twelve years ago, he embarked upon an intellectual venture to narrate the contemporary Sikh aspirational movement. The main aim was to enable a narrative of the 1984 from the Sikh point of view. This was envisaged because most writings about the subject did little justice to the Sikhs. The demands of the Sikhs and their aspirations, their doubts and apprehensions, and their religious and political aims were either out rightly denigrated or distorted. Sardar Ajmer Singh's first book *Veehvin Sadi Di Sikh Rajniti: Ik Ghulami to Doosri Ghulami Tak* (Twentieth Century Sikh Politics: From One Slavery into Another) had triggered a massive thought process in the community and intellectual world. It had analyzed the tragic journey of the community from the imperialist British colonial times to its fight for survival under the Hindu political supremacy in India. Four years later, in 2007, his next work *Kis Bidh Ruli Patshahi* (Whither Went Sovereignty), the author brought to the fore the truth about established basic lines of thought in the light of historical truths. Now, Sardar Ajmer Singh's third work in the series *1984 Unchitviya Kehar* (1984 Unimagined Crisis) is ready to hit the stores by this month end. He has analyzed the past in the light of the present and tried to understand the present with the benefit of the hindsight. Coming at a time when the community is observing the 25th anniversary of the attack on Golden Temple, Amritsar, this book is all the more significant and perhaps a most poignant way to remember the ones who are no more and learn from history's harsh lessons.
